When is Groundhog Day 2026?

Groundhog Day occurs each year on Feb. 2. This year, Groundhog Day falls on a Monday.

Groundhog Day is not a federal holiday, so banks, mail and trash services, schools, grocery stores, federal offices, local governments, libraries and stock markets will be open. But in Punxsutawney, celebrations featuring talent shows, banquets and performances are held to commemorate the day.

Which nations were involved in a war triggered by the shooting of a pig?

If you picked “B” you’d be correct. ‘The Pig War’ is perhaps one of the most obscure and unusual wars in history. The story begins back in 1846 when the Oregon Treaty was signed between the US & Britain. The treaty aimed to put to rest a long-standing border dispute between the US and British North America (Canada), specifically relating to the land between the Rocky Mountains and the Pacific coastline. Judging by reports of the time, both sets of islanders actually got along rather well. However, this was not to last. On June 15th, 1859, a British pig accidentally wandered onto the land of Lyman Cutlar, an American farmer. When Cutlar noticed the pig eating some of his potatoes he was incensed, and in a fit of rage shot and killed the pig.
